

# LEBECK “RISE UP” 2025 SCHOLARSHIP (Renewal)



The **SUTTER YUBA COMMUNITY FOUNDATION** invites applicants to apply for a renewal of the LeBeck “Rise Up” scholarship for previous recipients. This is a \$500 renewal scholarship for a trade school or community college and \$1,000 award for 4-year university. This scholarship is to be awarded from an endowment grant donated by Steven and Gayle LeBeck.

## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the scholarship, student applicants must

1. Been a previous recipient of the LeBeck Scholarship,
2. Maintain a current 2.0 GPA overall, and
3. Show that, despite obstacles, students have the drive and perseverance to strive for further education and a better life. Obstacles might be such issues as a difficult family life, health, extreme poverty or homelessness, or a learning disability.

**TRANSCRIPT**

Include a copy of your current trade school or college/university transcripts.

**ESSAY**

- A. Type (font size 12, double spaced) or write legibly an essay regarding your educational and career goals. Include reasons for your choice of training program, area of major and a statement of how any scholarship funds received would be used in reaching your stated goals.
- B. Clearly state your personal financial responsibility and your family's ability to assist financially in your education. 500 words maximum. Be concise and thorough. List any other financial aid you are receiving.
- C. Share a personal obstacle.

**RESUME**

Including all extracurricular and co-curricular activities for the past 4 years, broken down by year. Include employment, community service, sports, awards, and leadership positions. Include the number of hours/days served for volunteer work and or employment.
